In order to conduct this research, we are seeking to collect tissue that is left over from studies that are required for your clinical care such as blood draws, bone marrow biopsies, or other biopsies. Except for giving potentially a small sample of blood, you will not be asked to undergo any procedure solely for this study.

This research study involves collection of leftover sample and storage for later research testing. It is currently not known how samples will be used at this time. Your name and any other identifying information will be removed from your sample. A code linking your name to the sample is only accessible by the study's leader Dr. Angela Fleischman.
